## THE FACTS

Class size is limited to 25 participants with an enrollment deadline in mid-July of the class year.

The program consists of a kick-off Social and Team Building events in August (attendance at both is mandatory), nine monthly day-long sessions, a day trip to the Capitol in Austin and a graduation dinner in May.

Monthly sessions begin in September and are typically held the second Tuesday of each month thereafter. There may be an occasional exception to this due to scheduling conflicts, but advance notice of a date change will be given to all class participants.

Participants must attend 80% of the class sessions to qualify to graduate from the program.

### **Following graduation, participants will:**

Support the next year's class by serving as a class co-chair or assisting the Program Coordinator at a session of your choosing while remaining engaged with the program. Continue expanding their experience and contacts through participation in the Leadership Northeast Alumni group.
